4	<p><b>Reports from Parish Council –</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ <b>Recreation Field and future management of the site.</b></li> <li>○ <b>Footpaths</b></li> <li>○ <b>Climate Change and the Action Plan</b></li> <li>○ <b>Affordable Housing</b></li> </ul> <p>The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting and invited individual Councillors to address the topics for the meeting.</p> <p>The Chairman updated the meeting on the work and plans for the recreation field. Kelliwick cricket club were playing their matches at this new venue. The football season had now finished.</p> <p>Biodiversity plans were in place to reduce the cutting and hedge trimming, leaving an area around the boundary.</p> <p>The old tree was now becoming home to bugs and insects and a new tree had been planted on the site.</p> <p>Cllr Tunnicliffe reported on work to the public rights of way and the cutting work to be done in June 2024. Ongoing maintenance work included replacement signs and a new gate being installed on the path adjacent to Woodland House.</p> <p>Cllrs Hardman and Skelton spoke about the Climate Change Action Plan and the seven policies within it. The council currently focusing on one action for each policy.</p> <p>The Chairman spoke about the conversations with Cornwall Council and reported no action had been taken since the end of March 2024. The council were seeking resident's views on whether or not they wanted an affordable housing scheme in Golberdon and if there was a need for such a development. Cornwall Council do not want to take a project forward and this is why the parish council are seeking interest before making a decision to be involved.</p>	

	A potential site owned by Cornwall Council had been identified and they wished to dispose of this land for housing, but further consultation was needed.	
<b>5</b>	<b>Reports from parish organisations.</b> Recycling – Local resident Alison Humphreys spoke about the Charity Recycling Project that continued to be well supported raising £15,000 over the last five years.	
<b>6</b>	<b>Questions from parishioners and public.</b> <b>Parish Council website</b> – A parishioner spoke about the publication of documents on the parish council website.  <b>Parish Hall</b> – The new entry system to the hall was mentioned. This was a matter for the hall committee. Chris Beckett from the hall committee mentioned their annual general meeting on 28 <sup>th</sup> May 2024 to which everyone was welcome to attend.
